REQUIREMENTS FOR APPROVAL AS A MEDICAL PRACTITIONER FOR SEAFARERS.

WARNING TO APPLICANTS:

A false declaration may lead to legal proceedings

For the purposes of approval as a medical practitioner for seafarers by the Kenya Maritime Authority, applicants must:

1. Submit a written application expressing interest to be approved to carry out medical examinations of seafarers attaching the following:
 - a) Copy of national identity or passport.
 - b) Two passport-size photos (with white background)
 - c) Certified degree certificate from a recognized university.
 - d) Proof of registration and valid annual subscription to the Kenya Medical Practitioners and Dentists Board.
 - e) Certified copy of KRA PIN number.
 - f) Certified and valid copy of value added tax(VAT) certificate.
 - g) Certificate of good conduct.

2. Submit document(s) to show facilities for examination that are conveniently situated for access by seafarers and enabling all the requirements of the medical fitness examination to be met and conducted in an environment of confidentiality, modesty and cleanliness.
