STRONG WIND'S ADVISORY

No 03 of 2021

16th July, 2021

Kenya Maritime Authority (KMA) advises all mariners and fisher folk that there will be Strong southerly winds of more than 30 knots (15.4 meters per second) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu in the afternoons on Friday 16th July, 2021. The wind speed is expected to strengthen to more than 40 knots (20.6 M/S) on Saturday 17th to Sunday 18th July, 3:00am. Thereafter, the wind speed is likely to reduce to 30 knots from Monday 19th to Tuesday 20th July, 2021.

Poor visibility is expected due to potential heavy rainfall expected.

Small boats and crafts advised not to venture into the sea especially in the afternoon because of potential strong winds and heavy rainfall expected.

KMA Further advises fisher folk, all operating vessels, passengers and the general public venturing into the open sea during this period to maintain caution and continue to follow up on weather updates which will be disseminated in case of any significant changes observed.
