CONSTRUCTION OF KENYA MARITIME AUTHORITY (KMA) HEADQUARTERS-EXCAVATION WORKS

KMA has adhered to the NEMA's direction vide letter Ref. No. NEMA/MSA/PORT/INS/VOL.1/01/31 dated 29th August, 2017 and received by KMA on 30th August, 2017 to stop excavation works to avert any risk arising from caving-in of neighbouring boundary wall with Reef Flats. NEMA also informed the tenants of Reef Flats vide the above mentioned letter to vacate the Flat and relocate to other residence for safety of their lives.

In this regard and in response to the tenants' letter to the Authority dated 1st September, 2017, KMA has facilitated the relocation of six affected tenants and their families to alternative accommodation. The Project's Committee composed of officers from State Department of Public Works, KMA, Lins Consult and EPCO Builders will ensure strict adherence to NEMA's environmental guidelines as the Project progresses.
