UPGRADING OF THE RECORD OF KENYAN SEAFARERS

The mandate of Kenya Maritime Authority (KMA) is to coordinate, regulate and oversee the country's maritime affairs. One of the Authority's key function is to establish a framework for human resource development in the maritime sector, which involves preparation of the national plan for seafarers training, certification, employment and welfare.

On 28th May 2019, KMA will conduct a routine review and update of its database on all Kenyans from the hospitality sector who are certified and ready to work as seafarers.

For this purpose, all Kenyans with Degree/Diploma in hospitality management, cruise shipping training or any other hospitality related training (laundry, housekeeping, bartender, food handling etc) from a recognized training institution or with Certificate of Proficiency are encouraged to apply. A second international language will be an added advantage.

Interested persons should attend in person with the following documents on the above mentioned dates:

- 1) Valid Kenyan Passport
- 2) Certificate of Good conduct
- 3) Valid Seafarer Medical Certificate
- 4) Valid STCW Certificate
- 5) A copy of a Valid National Identification Card (ID)
- 6) Copies of Certificates/ Credentials from a recognized Hospitality Training Institution
- 7) Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate
