KMA Statement on Vessel Detention in Tanzania

The Kenya Maritime Authority (KMA) acknowledges reports regarding the detention of a Kenyan-flagged vessel, *M/V SEA MFALME*, in the United Republic of Tanzania.

The matter is currently under review, with the Authority working closely with relevant Government agencies and counterparts in Kenya and Tanzania to verify the circumstances and facilitate appropriate follow-up actions.

KMA wishes to assure stakeholders that the situation is being handled through established intergovernmental and regulatory frameworks. Further communication will be issued as appropriate.

The Authority remains committed to safeguarding the credibility of Kenya's ship registry and ensuring adherence to applicable maritime standards.
